Segway – the innovative Personal Transporter

The Segway PT is designed to operate as a pedestrian device anywhere someone can safely walk. It's eco-friendly, powered by a pair of lithium-ion batteries that recharge by plugging it into any wall outlet. It's relatively maintenance-free, with no oil to change or clutch to replace. And it's reliable, using redundant subsystems to continuously ensure you remain balanced.

Step on a Segway PT and it remains stationary and upright, balancing you appropriately. Shift your weight forward, backward, left or right, and LeanSteer® technology immediately sends you gliding in the precise direction you want to go, at exactly the speed you want to move. A Segway PT quickly feels like an extension of your own body, making it easy for you to remain confident, comfortable, and in control.

The unique technology inside of the Segway PT consists of several sensors, mechanic components and a control system, which balances the machine and moves the wheels. Five gyroscope and two acceleration indicators capture the environment and the position of the body 100 times in a second. Complete redundancy of electronic, motor and power supply means a maximum of security.

The i2 models (with vehicle registration) are used for the Segway Citytours. Since November 2007 Segway i2 models are legally allowed on Swiss roads. The range is 38 km on a single battery charge, the maximum speed is reduced to 20 km/h.

Conditions of Participation

To ride a Segway PT a valid driver's license is required (car category B or motorbike category A or A1, till 45km/h). The minimum age is 16 years with motorbike license. There is a minimum weight of 40 kg and a maximum weight of 120 kg for each participant. Previous consumption of alcohol, drugs or strong medication is not allowed. If one or more rules are ignored participants can be excluded from the tour.

Driving Training

Safety is our first priority which is why we conduct an extensive driving training (especially braking training) with safety instructions and an introduction to the Segway PT with all our clients before starting the tour. Training usually lasts approximately 20 to 30 minutes. This way we can ensure a safe and relaxed trip.

Insurance

Liability (covering third-party claims) and comprehensive insurance (theft, environmental influences etc.) for the units are included.

Any damage to persons and units or equipment which directly or indirectly results from the client's negligence shall in its entirety be compensated by the client. A corresponding disclaimer will be distributed and signed by each participant. motion tools GmbH does not accept any liability.

We have a third party insurance for all of our Segway PTs, which covers damage to persons and property on your tour. However, you are liable for all damages to the Segway PT, which occurred due to your own fault. We offer a motor own damage insurance, which covers these costs – without any cost sharing. To ensure maximal pleasure on our Segway tours, we recommend you the motor own-damage insurance for only SFR 5.- per person - bookable only in advance.

Tour Description

Our guides show you their city. Come with us on an interesting and unforgettable tour through Interlaken and the surrounding area with the innovative Segway!

Our tour begins at the City Hotel Oberland and passes over the emerald green waters of the Aare River into the picturesque old city of Unterseen, whose roots date back to the late 13th Century. Here we have a fabulous view of the mountain scenery of the Eiger, Mönch and Jungfrau. We continue along the Lombach River until we arrive at the well-known Neuhaus, where the Lombach flows into the Lake of Thun. At the Neuhaus we enjoy the perfect combination of water and mountain worlds in an idyllic setting.

As the tour continues we stop at the the Ruine Weissenau, a former castle built at the edge of the lake. We cross again the Aare River, pass the Interlaken West train station and go on through the Wagneren canyon. Here we can test our mastery of Segway driving and experience the capabilities of the Segway PT that carries us up a lengthy ascent with undiminished speed. Other sights along the way include the Rugenbräu Brewery, the amazing Ruine Unspunnen and the village center of Wilderswil. We drive across the RUAG Airport to Bönigen and the Lake of Brienz with its one of a kind enchanting clear blue-green water.

The end of our varied tour includes the Interlaken Castle, the Japanese Friendship Gardens and the Höhematte in the center of town. We arrive back at our start point in a total of 2.5 hours.
