

## Climb the Eiger Northface

Nothing in Switzerland is more impressive than the towering wall of the Eiger North Face. With the aid of ladders and fixed cables, even novices can get up close to this famous high alpine climb. The Via Ferrata "Rotstock" climbs the vertical wall on the west side of the face where you summit on the Rotstock Peak at 2,663 m (8737 ft). Guided by a certified international UIAGM mountain guide, this trip allows beginners to experience a mountaineering environment without requiring technical climbing skills.



### Quick facts

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<b>Recommended for</b>	Moderate hikers confident with heights
<b>What's included</b>	UIAGM mountain guide, climbing harness, safety equipment and helmet
<b>What to bring</b>	Warm hiking clothes, thin gloves, rain jackets, trekking boots, sunglasses, food and drinks for one day, backpack
<b>Requirements</b>	Children under 12 only with adult supervision Max. weight 120 kg (265lbs)
<b>Duration</b>	6 hours from Grindelwald including transport and preparation time. 3 hours hiking and climbing
<b>Season</b>	17.06.18 – 30.09.18
<b>Departures</b>	Departs every 2nd Sunday or on request for groups
<b>Capacities</b>	8 per guide. Multiple guides per trip
<b>Prices</b>	CHF 185.00.

### Good to know

- Meet your guide in Grindelwald and journey together to Eigergletscher
- Tickets to Eigergletscher are not included but can be arranged on request
- The climb is 260 meters vertical
- Participants need to be comfortable with heights
- The route climbs into a high alpine environment
- Lunch takes place on the Rotstock summit at 2,663m (8737ft)
- The trip is guided by an international certified mountain guide UIAGM
- Participants must bring good and sturdy trekkingboots (available for rent)
